• Accumulating vocabulary: In addition to the words in the nursery rhymes, common supplementary vocabulary related to the rhymes are also grouped together so that kids can get familiar with these common words in both Chinese and English.

• Practicing vocabulary: little readers can adapt the nursery rhymes with supplementary words learned in the section. It often creates a funny variation of the rhymes which will help them understand and memorize the words better in the context of the rhymes.

· Expanding common knowledge: According to the contents of the rhymes, activities related to crafting, scientific experiments, fun science facts, and social skills are provided to promote creativity, curiosity, and collaboration. It enhances the language learning process and makes it both fun and educational at the same time.

 Bilingual Children's reading audios: By scanning the QR code in the book or using a reading pen, children can listen to the bilingual nursery rhymes read by a few Chinese American children. Their reading is clear, authentic and adorable, attracting the little readers to imitate their pronunciation and repeat after them.

· Explanatory family shows: The meaning, key words and background of the nursery rhymes are explained through the conversations between Tian Tian, Ya Ya, Mom and Dad, who are virtual characters in the family shows. These family shows are educational and hilarious. Children can learn the rhymes unconsciously while listening to it.


